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FEATURED WHITE HALF BOTTLE

Pinot Blanc, R. Sinskey, Los Carneros, 2014 - \$49

Dr. Robert Sinskey founded his winery in Napa Valley in 1988 with a vision to make balanced wines intended to pair well with cuisine. Sinskey reminisces that wine culture at the time felt more like a competitive sport where bigger is always better, and high scores from critics drove the American wine market. Pinot Blanc (or Pinot Bianco to our Italian bretheren), is a grape that is best appreciated for its subtleties, unlike its more broad-shouldered "competitor", oaked California Chardonnay. Sinskey proudly produces this limited label only releasing the Pinot Blanc in half bottles and magnums because, in his own words, "You should either start with it or party with it!"

Champagne has a rival-- the Italian sparkling wine zone Franciacorta. Not just following, but enforcing even stricter laws than Champagne, Franciacorta proves itself an apt competitor in the contest of the world's greatest sparkling wines. Using Pinot Nero, Pinot Bianco, and Chardonnay, the region remains relatively obscure, awarding its followers with great value. FEATURED PIEMONTESE WHITE

Langhe, Paolo Scavino, "Sorriso", 2017 - \$53

Recently named a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its vineyard landscape, the Langhe region of Piedmont is one of the most favorable places for growing vines in the world. Met with the grandeur of endless folding hillsides planted predominantly to indigenous grapes, it's tempting for one to imagine almost ANY grape variety's potential to thrive there. "Sorriso" is a unique blend of international grape varieties not typical for the region. While traditionalists may argue that only local grapes fully express the sacred terroir of the Langhe, Scavino saw the potential to expand the magic of Piedmont by this beautifully fresh and vibrant expression of Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, and Viognier. FEATURED BARBERA D'ASTI

Superiore, Marchesi Incisa della Rocchetta,
"Sant'Emiliano", 2016 - \$87

The Incisa della Rocchetta family is probably best known as the proprietors of Tenuta San Guido, the winery responsible for creating the first "Super Tuscan": Sassicaia, but the family's provenance is not in Tuscany but rather in Piedmont, on the bank of the Tanaro River just east of Asti. "Sant'Emiliano" spends 18 months in French oak barrels, which affords the wine an elegance and depth of flavor not typically found in Barbera wines. This wine offers incredible value and is a rare opportunity to enjoy a little known wine produced by one of Italy's greatest and most revered winemaking families.

Giovanni Rosso, 2013 - \$111

Whether you're a vintner, enologist, sommelier, or simply lover of fine wine, all would agree that Barolo stands among the most elite wines of the world. Just as Burgundy lovers forever debate the nuances of Vosne-Romanée versus, say, Gevrey-Chambertin, Barolo enthusiasts of today discuss structural differences and aromatic distinctions found in each of Barolo's unique subzones. Giovanni Rosso produces Barolo from the Helvetian soils of Serralunga d'Alba resulting in wines with more robust structure and deeper complexity. If Barolo is the King of Wines, we think Giovanni Rosso is the King of Serralunga.

While '14 was a challenging vintage, all the fruit from their top level "Salco" bottling and Riserva went into this Vino Nobile offering us a wine of true depth and character.

Brunello di Montalcino has risen to be the premier interpretation of Tuscan Sangiovese. At the Riserva level, it ranks among some of the highest aging requirement of any other table wine in the world. By law, it may not be released until the 6th year following harvest, and is mandated to mature in oak for a minimum of 2 years. Full in body, a Riserva designated Brunello expresses all the traditional flavors one expects from the varietal with an emphasis on black cherry, chocolate notes, and a dark earthiness. The resulting wine is a more pronounced, luxurious bottling that only the town of Montalcino can provide.

The term "Super Tuscan" was coined by American journalists who welcomed these fuller-bodied, more polished Tuscan reds to the market. At a time when a majority of Tuscan wines were synonymous with thin, mediocre table wine, a few restless vintners set out to challenge the status quo. The wines were enthusiastically received by critics and ultimately led to a wine quality renaissance in Tuscany that has been on the rise ever since! The first bottle associated with the movement was Tenuta San Guido's 1968 "Sassicaia", vinified from Cabernet grapes on the Tuscan coast of Bolgheri. On the wave of their uncle Mario's overnight success with Sassicaia, nephews Piero and Lodovico Antinori adopted their own unique style with the release of Tignanello, Solaia, and Ornellaia. We proudly offer a library of these world class wines from our cellar, many of which only a handful of bottles still exist.

This was the exclamation of an experienced sommelier when he tasted Buglioni's first Ripasso wine in 2000. This incident gave birth to the name of this wine, "Il Bugiardo", which translates to "The Liar". This Ripasso process involves blending wine from partially dried grapes, and freshly vinified wine that has been "re-passed" over the leftovers from the production of Amarone. It creates a wine that is reminiscent of Amarone, but with a little more drinkability.

DRC vs. Leroy...Lafite vs. Latour...Conterno vs. Gaja... the wine geek's equivalent to a political debate (notwithstanding a little BS) in a quest for the single greatest expression of a particular wine. In Valpolicella, two producers indisputably reign at the top of the quality pyramid: Quintarelli and Dal Forno. Both producers commit maniacal attention to fruit selection, sorting down to the individual berry if necessary to achieve the best extraction of flavor possible. Quintarelli's genius in the cellar is carried out through more traditional methods of élevage, while Dal Forno boasts one of the most technologically advanced wineries in the world. Preference in the resulting wines can be polarizing depending on the taster, but the quality of both is unquestionable. Where Quintarelli masterfully draws elegance and otherworldly aromas out of his Amarones, Dal Forno excels in achieving depths of concentration winemakers in Napa only dream about.

Poets like Horace, Catallus, and Pliny the Elder wrote poetry about the Roman Empire's finest wine, originally known as Falernian. The quality of the wine is so impressive that the 121 BC vintage was toasted in 60 BC after Julius Caesar conquered Spain. Mount Massico, the source, is blessed by constant ash deposits from Campania's volcanic arc composed of "erupters" like Vesuvius, Campi Flegrei, and Epomeo. The local Aglianico grape thrives off the mineral rich volcanic ash giving body and density to a wine famous for over two millennia.

Built on tradition and heritage, the Poli family traces their lineage in the Veneto back to the time of the Renaissance. The distillery was founded in 1898 near Bassano del Grappa. Since that time it has produced Grappa, brandy, gin, and a variety of liqueurs based from the pomace of the surrounding wine producers. The Torcolato pays homage to the dessert wine style of the same name from the Breganze hills of the Veneto region. It is a single-vintage bottling made from the pomace of Vespaiolo and Friulano grapes and then aged for at least 6 months in stainless steel.

The Caol Ila distillery is the largest producer on Islay, and although one of the lighter malts produced on the island, there is still a relatively gentle peat presence at the core of the spirit. The total maturation in barrel was 12 Years, 11 months with 33 of those months spent in the Sassicaia barrels.
