What Olivier is able to accomplish in Saint-Aubin makes you wonder what he could do with prime spots in Meursault, Corton-Charlemagne, the Montrachets or even Chablis. Olivier is intense, and his wines are the same.

FEATURED CHAMPAGNE

Pierre Péters, "Cuvée de Réserve", NV - \$152

Camille Péters, around 1919, was one of the first growers of the Champagne region to decide to bottle wine under his own name. In 1932, at the ripe old age of 12, Pierre Péters, the eldest son of Camille, began to attend his first exhibitions alone and develop sales for his father's brand, and never looked back. He took over operations in 1944, and released his first vintage in 1946 under the "Pierre Péters" brand. The estate, now run by Rodolphe Péters, owns just over 19 hectares of sustainably farmed vineyards , all of which are primarily located in the Côte des Blancs, where the soils are chalky and Chardonnay is king. Their flagship Champagne, the "Cuvée de Réserve", is a Blanc de Blancs style made from 100% Grand Cru Chardonnay grapes.

Domaine Vacheron, "Les Romains", 2015 - \$129

The Vacheron family name in Sancerre is viticultural royalty. Three generations ago the family took over their first vineyards. As their family grew so did the pedigree of their bottlings. Now encompassing biodynamic farming, hand harvests, and some of the finest vineyards in Sancerre. "Les Romains" was planted sixty years ago by then patriarchs Denis and Jean-Louis on south facing, silex soils. It is not a wine trying to re-invent Sancerre, but to be an elevated version of the classic style.

FEATURED RIESLING SPÄTLESE

Max Ferd. Richter, "Graacher Dompropst", 2003 - \$79

The estate of Max Ferd. Richter has been passed down from father to son for the past 300 years. The current reins are held by Dr. Dirk Richter, the 9th generation. Richter produces world-class Rieslings from some of the most esteemed vineyards in the Mosel. The same attention is paid to all vines, from the QBAs on up through the Eisweins. Their grapes are harvested much later than that of most growers and is done entirely by hand. Three passes are done to select the best qualities to eliminate all inferior grapes and to keep perfect botrytis bunches. Contrary to popular belief, Riesling develops beautifully with age. Its residual sugar and acidity help to preserve the wine while all of the wonderful flavors come together over time. This 2003 bottling from the Dompropst vineyard, near the town of Graach, is just starting to hit its stride right now.

Who would do something that crazy? John Alban would. John was a trailblazer, and many vintners eventually saw the light, and followed him to the promised land. He has sold his vine cuttings over the years to other vintners to begin their own Rhône adventures. This has now brought current Viognier acreage in California from 0 to over 2000, and Syrah from a mere few hundred to 17,000!!! There is no one who did more for the exposure of these wines in the United States than John. His wines have always been an expression of the true potential of Rhône varietals in California, and this Syrah is no different.

No winery is more famous, or produces such legen...wait for it...dary wines in Burgundy than Domaine de la Romanée-Conti. The domaine has been co-owned by 2 families, the de Villaine's and the Roch's/Leroy's, since 1942. Aubert de Villaine, a humble, charming and highly intelligent man who is acutely conscious of the history of the domaine and the responsibility he bears towards it, has been the manager and face of the domaine since 1991, when Lalou Bize-Leroy left to focus on her own domaine. Often abbreviated as DRC, the winery makes some of the most exclusive wines in the world. 98% of their vineyard holdings are in Grand Cru vineyards, including their 2 "monopoles", La Tâche and Romanée-Conti. DRC's wines, for those lucky enough to have tried them, are regarded as the pinnacle of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.

Originally a chef, he caught the wine bug, became a sommelier, and soon enough he dove headfirst into winemaking. He planted 4 hectares of vines in 1989 with the help of his friend Yves Cuilleron, made his first vintage in 1991, and has never looked back since. His domaine has grown exponentially since then, and produces deliciously complex wines out of Syrah, as well as a small amount of Viognier, from appellations all over the Northern Rhône. This Côte-Rôtie is sourced from a collection of lieu-dits, all in the Côte Brune, and it is named after 2 of the growers many of these grapes are sourced from, Mr. Blanc and Mr. Gallet

This was the exclamation of an experienced sommelier when he tasted Buglioni's first Ripasso wine in 2000. This incident gave birth to the name of this wine, "Il Bugiardo", which translates to "The Liar". This Ripasso process involves blending wine from partially dried grapes, and freshly vinified wine that has been "re-passed" over the leftovers from the production of Amarone. It creates a wine that is reminiscent of Amarone, but with a little more drinkability.

FEATURED RIBERA DEL DUERO

Conde de San Cristóbal, 2014- \$73

Watch out Rioja, Ribera del Duero has been creeping up as one of Spain's premier red wine producing regions. Here, producers are crafting wines from the local Tinto Fino (Tempranillo), as well as small amounts of French varietals. Conde de San Cristóbal is the "sister bodega" of Marqués de Vargas in Rioja. They practice sustainable farming (no herbicides/pesticides), allow for indigenous yeast fermentation and the wines are bottled with no fining or filtering, resulting in an unprocessed and fully natural wine. These wines are able to combine power and concentration of fruit with the elegance and terroir of an Old World wine.
