## **FEATURED CHAMPAGNE**

Pierre Péters, "Cuvée de Réserve", NV - \$152

*Camille Péters, around 1919, was one of the first growers of the Champagne region to decide to bottle wine under his own name. In 1932, at the ripe old age of 12, Pierre Péters, the eldest son of Camille, began to attend his first exhibitions alone and develop sales for his father's brand, and never looked back. He took over operations in 1944, and released his first vintage in 1946 under the "Pierre Péters" brand. The estate, now run by Rodolphe Péters, owns just over 19 hectares of sustainably farmed vineyards , all of which are primarily located in the Côte des Blancs, where the soils are chalky and Chardonnay is king. Their flagship Champagne, the "Cuvée de Réserve", is a Blanc de Blancs style made from 100% Grand Cru Chardonnay grapes.*

Domaine Vacheron, "Les Romains", 2016 - \$129

*The Vacheron family name in Sancerre is viticultural royalty. Three generations ago the family took over their first vineyards. As their family grew so did the pedigree of their bottlings. Now encompassing biodynamic farming, hand harvests, and some of the finest vineyards in Sancerre. "Les Romains" was planted sixty years ago by then patriarchs Denis and Jean-Louis on south facing, silex soils. It is not a wine trying to re-invent Sancerre, but to be an elevated version of the classic style.*

## **FEATURED RIESLING SPÄTLESE**

Max Ferd. Richter, "Graacher Dompropst", 2003 - \$79

*The estate of Max Ferd. Richter has been passed down from father to son for the past 300 years. The current reins are held by Dr. Dirk Richter, the 9th generation. Richter produces world-class Rieslings from some of the most esteemed vineyards in the Mosel. The same attention is paid to all vines, from the QBAs on up through the Eisweins. Their grapes are harvested much later than that of most growers and is done entirely by hand. Three passes are done to select the best qualities to eliminate all inferior grapes and to keep perfect botrytis bunches. Contrary to popular belief, Riesling develops beautifully with age. Its residual sugar and acidity help to preserve the wine while all of the wonderful flavors come together over time. This 2003 bottling from the Dompropst vineyard, near the town of Graach, is just starting to hit its stride right now.*

The label change also brought a stylistic change in the wines to a more lean, restrained style. He re-launched the Pax brand in 2014, again showcasing Syrah from many of the best vineyard sites in northern California. "The Hermit" is made from 100% Syrah, with grapes sourced from all 5 of their Syrah vineyards.*

These days, he has moved operations to a larger facility on Vashon Island, and he's been especially keen on focusing on clonal selections that best fit the growing conditions in each particular vineyard. The Ciel du Cheval vineyard, planted in 1975 and one of the most prestigious in Washington, has been being used by Chris since his first vintage. He says, "I am not interested in the similarities of my wines, but the differences. The different identities of our vineyards and varietals, which explore the identity of Washington State as distinct from California or Bordeaux"*

The domaine has been co-owned by 2 families, the de Villaine's and the Roch's/Leroy's, since 1942. Aubert de Villaine, a humble, charming and highly intelligent man who is acutely conscious of the history of the domaine and the responsibility he bears towards it, has been the manager and face of the domaine since 1991, when Lalou Bize-Leroy left to focus on her own domaine. Often abbreviated as DRC, the winery makes some of the most exclusive wines in the world. 98% of their vineyard holdings are in Grand Cru vineyards, including their 2 "monopoles", La Tâche and Romanée-Conti. DRC's wines, for those lucky enough to have tried them, are regarded as the pinnacle of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay.*

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## **FEATURED CÔTE-RÔTIE**

**Bernard Levet, "La Chavaroche", 2011 - \$187**

*The story of this domaine begins in 1936, when Nicole Levet's grandfather first purchased vineyards in Ampuis. His wines were only sold to local bistros and cafes, and delivered in barrels. Then in 1966 Nicole's father, Marius Chambeyron, began bottling a small portion of the wine produced at the estate. Unfortunately, Nicole's father fell ill in 1982, and that next year Nicole's husband, Bernard Levet, took over winemaking and vineyard management duties. That precious 1983 vintage was when the domaine really began to develop. They have since increased their vineyard holdings, as well as expanded their cellar capacity. Although production is still small, they continue to produce some of the most rustic, classically-styled Côte-Rôtie in the market today.*

*The Mourvèdre grape loves the Mediterranean, and refuses to grow to its potential unless the vines abut the sea. Unfortunately for the grape, yacht owners feel the same way, and would prefer to "aller en vacances" along the sea as well. Vineyards were ripped up to make way for spas, slips, and hotels, until at last there was one last bastion of righteous Provençal Mourvèdre: Bandol. Bandol's prowess is its power. A brooding wine combining herbal tones native to the region with rich tannins and ethereal aromas easily described as hedonistic. The 2013 vintage was fantastic, but after five years the nose has really come to fruition, while the tannins still have the strength for the meal.*

*The story goes that when the Etruscans were chased out of central Italy to the North by the Romans, they eventually hid in the dense forests of Alba. The Romans knew vaguely where they were, but could never capture the fleeting tribe in the thick woods. Giving up the hunt the Romans would eventually name the region after the elusive Etruscans they thought to be barbarians: Barbaresco. The wines have always represented the most approachable form of the complex Nebbiolo grape, with softer tannins than their counterpart, Barolo, to the West. Wines from the region continue to benefit from age and only in the best vintages will they be declared Riserva. This ten year old wine optimizes the vintage, age worthiness, and riserva status' completely.*

## **FEATURED BAROLO**

Damilano, "Lecinquevigne", 2013 - \$121

*In the mid-19th century, Camillo Benso, "Conte di Cavour", the mayor of Grinzane Cavour invited the French enologist Louis Oudart to the Barolo region to improve the winemaking techniques of the local producers. Using techniques focusing on improving the hygiene of the cellar, Oudart was able to ferment the Nebbiolo must completely dry, making the first "modern" Barolo. This new, "dry" red wine soon became a favorite among the nobility of Turin and the ruling House of Savoy, giving rise to the popular description of Barolo as "The wine of kings, the king of wines". Damilano began vinifying wine from their estate in 1890, their classic "Lecinquevigne" is a blend of 5 single vineyards from different areas within the Barolo region.*

## **FEATURED CHIANTI CLASSICO GRAN SELEZIONE**

Castello di Ama, "San Lorenzo", 2014 - \$119

*Too often Chianti Classico gets associated with the wicker baskets of bulk Chianti, or under-appreciated against the grandness of Brunello di Montalcino. Classico, located in the heart of Tuscany has been regarded as Sangiovese's ideal home since the 13th century. Marco Pallanti began his impressive tenure as winemaker at Castello di Ama in 1982. Despite the region's reputation for poor quality at the time, Pallanti saw the potential in these ancient rolling hills. After apprenticing at Château Mouton Rothschild in Bordeaux, he entirely redeveloped the estate vineyards and was among the first to experiment with international grape varieties. One of his most recent accomplishments as President of the Chianti Classico Consorzio was establishing the "Gran Selezione" classification. After all, who's to say there can't be "Grand Cru" Chianti?*

## **FEATURED "SUPER TUSCAN"**

Mastrojanni, "San Pio", Toscana, 2015 - \$87

*In 1975, a lawyer named Gabriele Mastrojanni bought the San Pio and Loreto estates, which are concentrated in the southeastern part of Montalcino. Gabriele was entranced by the poor soils, the steep slopes and rugged vegetation. It seemed more suited to werewolves and chupacabra's than to cultivation of grapevines. Montalcino eventually turned into one of Italy's premiere wine regions, and it is here that Sangiovese is king. However...although Cabernet Sauvignon cannot legally be used in the production of Brunello di Montalcino, it grows so well here that Gabriele couldn't resist planting some at his San Pio estate anyway. Since 1997 this Cabernet has been blended with 20% declassified Brunello fruit to create "San Pio", a delicious Super Tuscan that invokes the thoughts of Napa Cabernet and Bordeaux, but the from the heart of Sangiovese country.*

Conde de San Cristóbal, 2014- \$73

*Watch out Rioja, Ribera del Duero has been creeping up as one of Spain's premier red wine producing regions. Here, producers are crafting wines from the local Tinto Fino (Tempranillo), as well as small amounts of French varietals. Conde de San Cristóbal is the "sister bodega" of Marqués de Vargas in Rioja. They practice sustainable farming (no herbicides/pesticides), allow for indigenous yeast fermentation and the wines are bottled with no fining or filtering, resulting in an unprocessed and fully natural wine. These wines are able to combine power and concentration of fruit with the elegance and terroir of an Old World wine.*

Luca, named after her eldest son, was created in order to show off the greatness of Argentinean wines from rigorously farmed, high altitude, low yield vineyards. This Malbec is sourced from vineyard sites with an average vine age of over 50 years!!*
